

Levels of membership

Full member

On payment of the membership fee (due annually in April of each year) a full member will receive a membership card and a Norfolk Fire Museum 'member' car windscreen sticker with the museums logo. They would also be able to vote at the Annual General Meeting, or other meetings, and after two years of membership, eligible to sit on the committee. They will be added to the museums email circulation list. Through this list they would be kept up to date with museum activities such as weekend workshops and other events as announced.

Junior member
